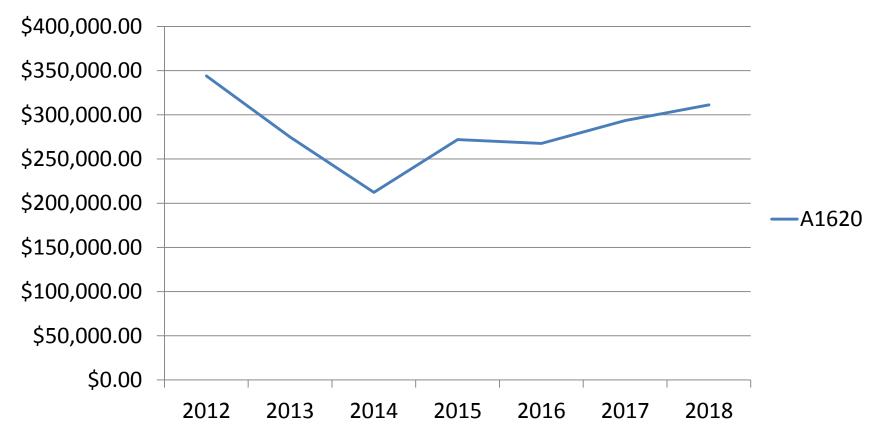

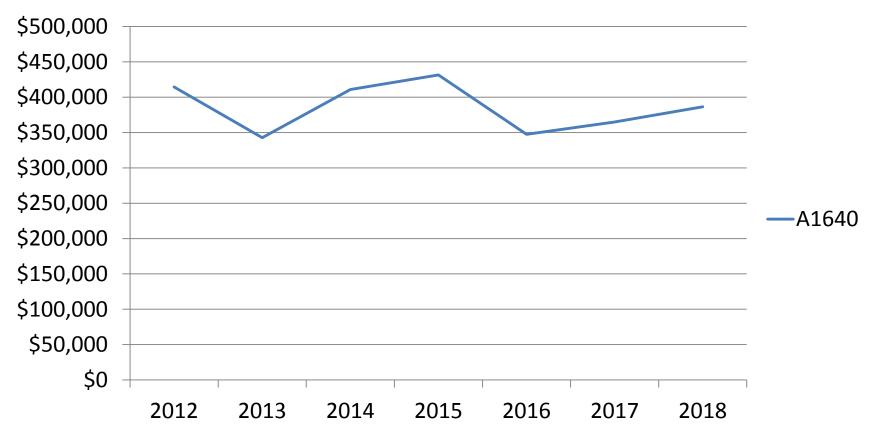

- Largest expenses janitorial supplies, elevator repair

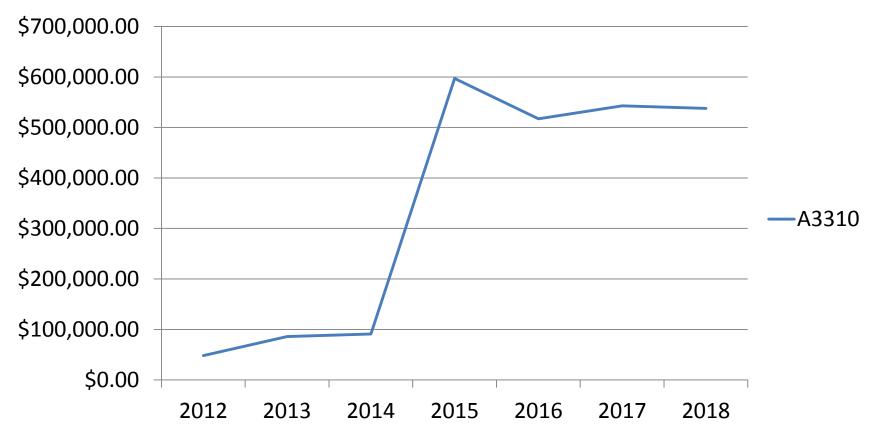

- Increase due to salaries and shop truck purchase

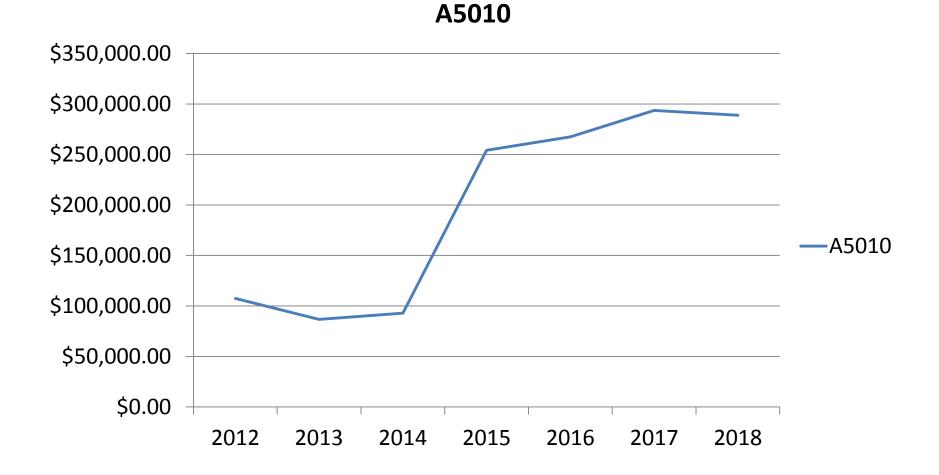

- Reduced .250 Other Equipment

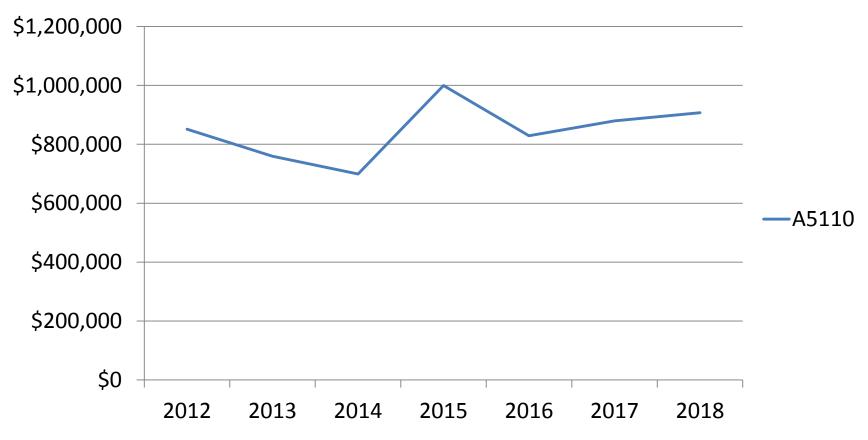

- Reduced .451 Consulting Fees

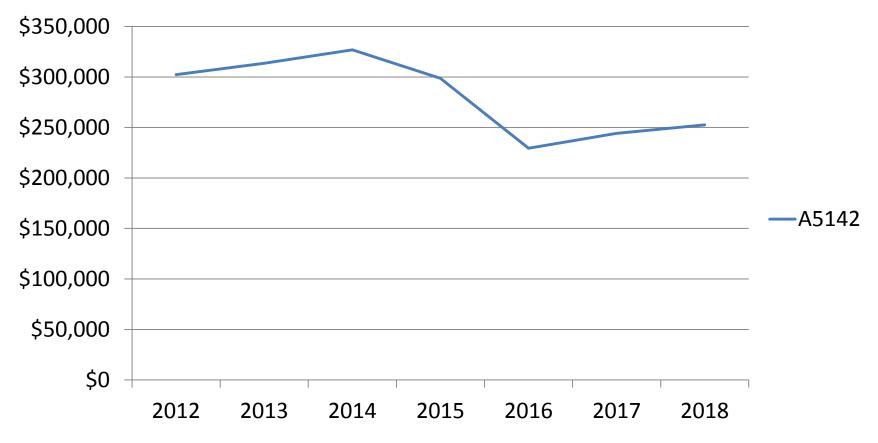

- Increase due to salary increases, training

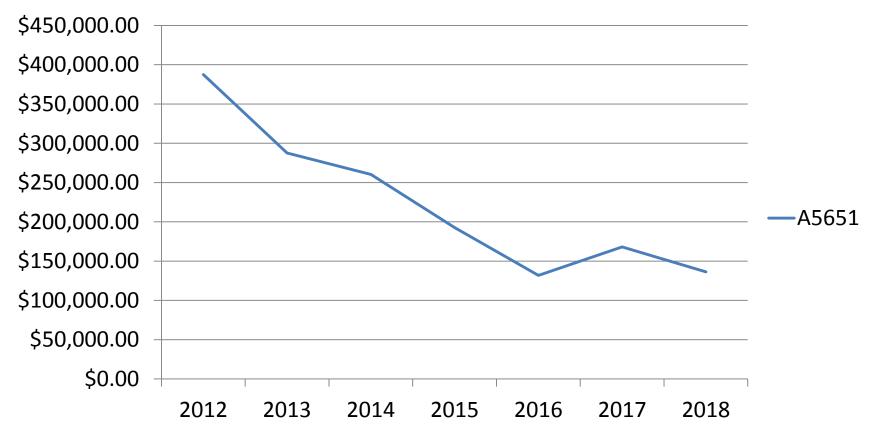

- Increase for snowblower attachment for sidewalk machine

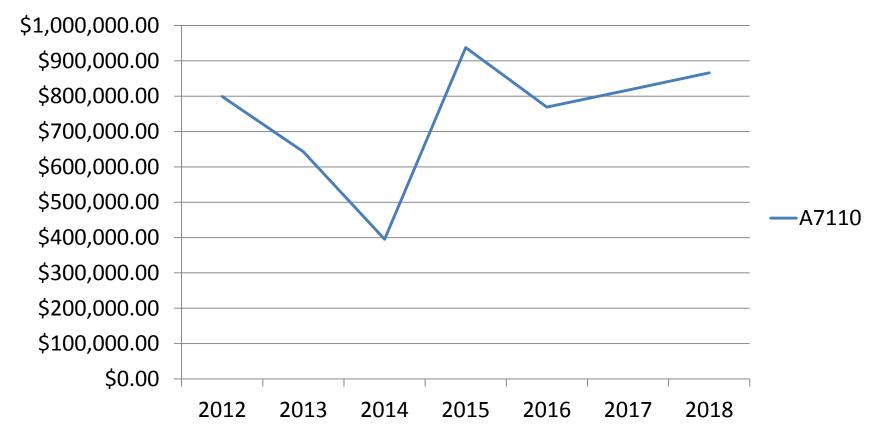

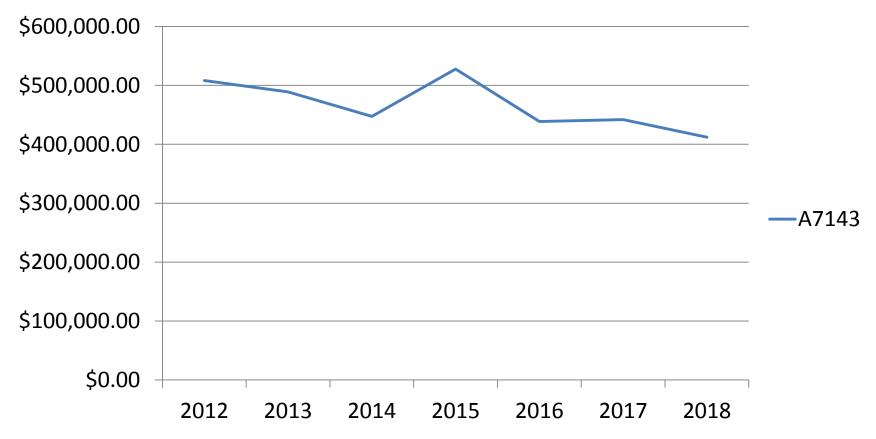

- Increase due to correct salary allocation, increase overtime and operating supplies

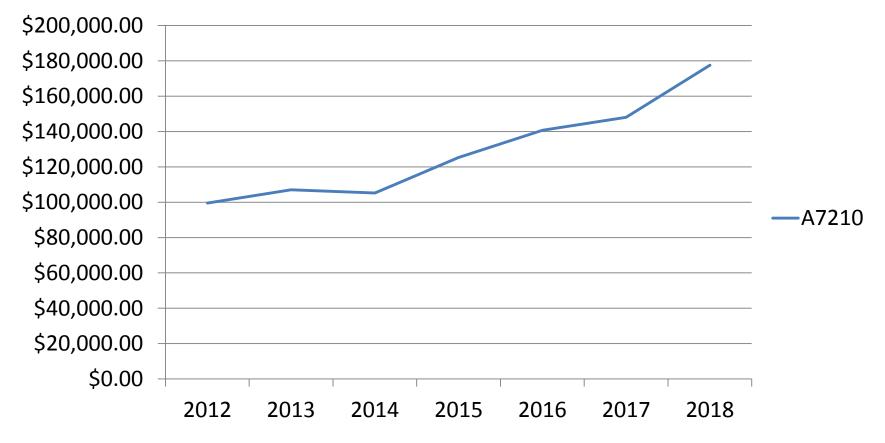

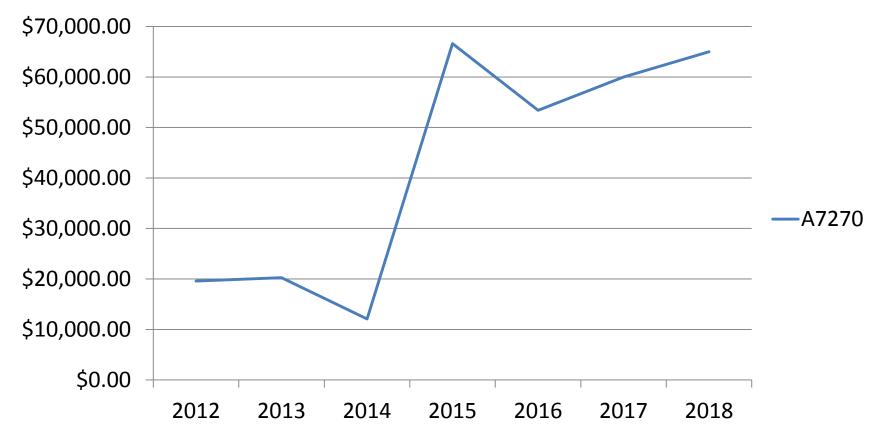

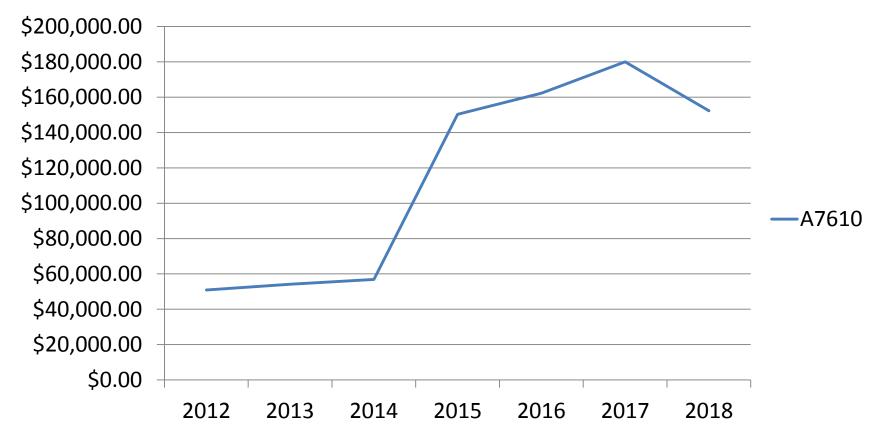

- Increase fees and services for additional events

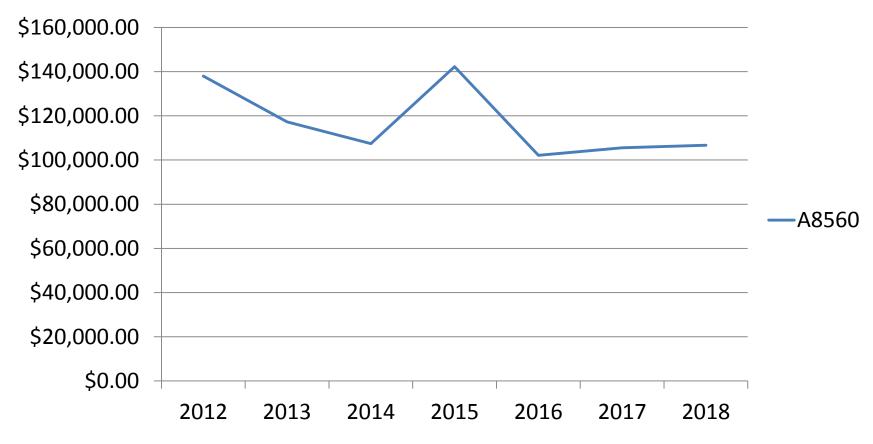

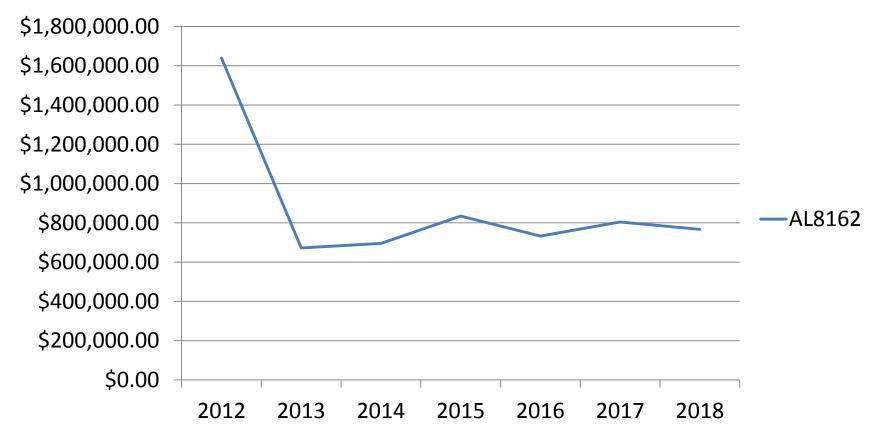

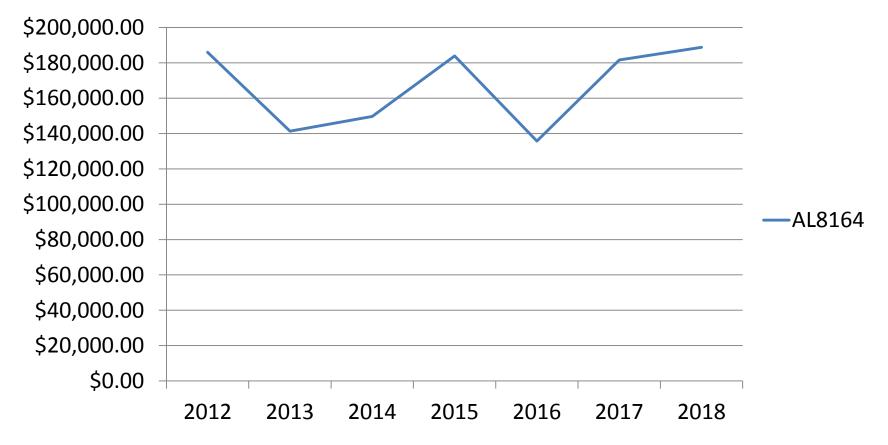


# AL8162 - Refuse Disposal

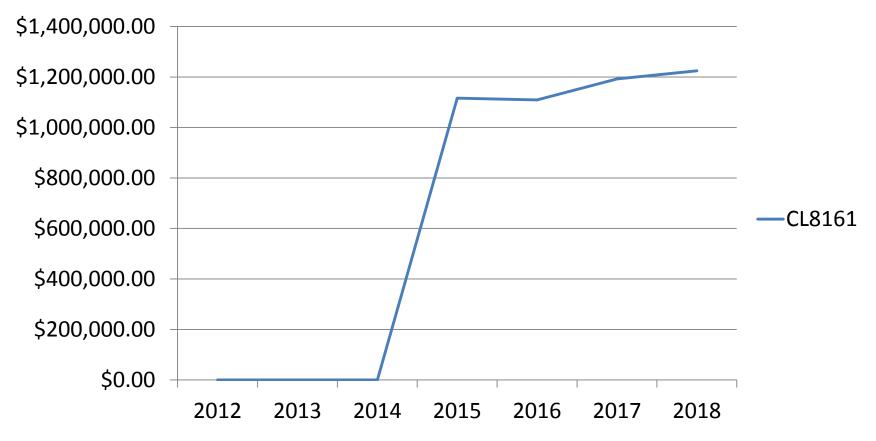
