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WHO WE ARE

A Continuum of Care (CoC) helps communities plan for and provide a full range of emergency, transitional, and permanent housing and other services to address the needs of persons experiencing homelessness. The PPCoC is a network of nonsocial service providers, healthcare profits, faith-based organizations, organizations, local governments, and community advocates aligned with one common mission: to make homelessness rare, brief, and nonrecurring and one-time in the Pikes Peak region. Since 2002, the PPCoC has been a leader in serving and prioritizing funding for the homeless and at-risk-of-homeless citizens of El Paso county. In that time, the PPCoC has created three different programs dedicated to planning, tracking, and coordinating homelessness.

Community Health Partnership has provided planning, administrative, and data services for the PPCoC since 2018.

STRATEGIC GOALS

Goal 1: Make homelessness rare by reducing the inflows of people who experience homelessness into the region.

Goal 2: Make homelessness brief by reducing the duration of time people spend in temporary shelter or unsheltered.

Goal 3: Make homelessness nonrecurring and one-time by improving system outcomes to permanent housing solutions.

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

- Achieve 15% reduction in first time homelessness.
- Increase exits to permanent housing from street outreach by 5%.
- Increase exits into temporary institutions from street outreach by 10%.

CALL TO ACTION



- Local community leadership's commitment to using quality data to better inform funding and strategic decision-making to end homelessness.
- Support and help message the PPCoC's Strategic Plan to end homelessness.
- Prioritize and expand funding and services that focus on permanent housing solutions.
