Emergency Sewer Repair Funding

Issue: The recent failure of the sanitary transmission line under East Cuba Road, near Old McHenry Road, has proven to be a costly repair. Estimates for emergency repairs are still being prepared, but will likely be significantly more than the \$611,230 previously approved by the Village Board. As a large unbudgeted expense, staff is evaluating all options for funding the repairs. The attached ordinance allows the village the flexibility to pursue the option of issuing debt as a funding source.

Analysis: At the September 21, 2015 board meeting, the Village Board authorized Berger Excavating to proceed with emergency sewer repairs in an amount not-to-exceed \$611,230. Subsequent to the meeting, additional sections of the sewer pipe were televised, identifying additional sections in need of serious repairs. The pipe has deteriorated beyond the point where lining is possible. Taking advantage of the opportunity to repair the larger section at once will allow for some economy of scale and save the village money in the long run. Staff from both the village and Manhard Engineering expect that the plans for the exact length of pipe needing replacement, scope of bypass pumping, and traffic detour plans will be finalized in the next few days.

Current estimates are that the project costs will exceed \$1 million. Unfortunately, this high an expense cannot be absorbed by the Water and Sewer fund without serious detriment to other critical capital projects. There is a strong possibility the village will need to issue debt in order As such, staff is proposing an ordinance for village board to fund the sewer repairs. consideration and approval that would protect the village's option of issuing debt after the repairs have been completed. The ordinance states a maximum of \$1.5 million in principal. This is

higher than the current estimate and will allow for any additional unknown expenses. Any actual

debt would be issued for the final determined amount.

The ordinance does not authorize the debt issuance, or guarantee the village will issue debt. It merely provides the opportunity for the village to authorize debt at a future date to cover expenses from these repairs. Without such ordinance, the village would only have a sixty (60) day window in which to issue the debt. Staff will bring forth any proposed debt issuance at a

later date if necessary, once the project plan has been completed.

Should any additional questions arise, staff from Finance and/or Community Services are both

available.

Recommendation: Staff recommends the Village Board approve the Ordinance expressing

official intent regarding certain capital expenditures to be reimbursed from proceeds of an

obligation to be issued by the Village of Lake Zurich.

ORDINANCE No. 2015-10-____

ORDINANCE expressing official intent regarding certain capital expenditures to be reimbursed from proceeds of an obligation to be issued by the Village of Lake Zurich, Lake County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Village of Lake Zurich, Lake County, Illinois (the "Village"), have developed a list of capital projects described in Exhibit A hereto (the "Projects"); and

WHEREAS, all or a portion of the expenditures relating to the Projects (the "Expenditures") (i) have been paid within the 60 days prior to the passage of this Ordinance or (ii) will be paid on or after the passage of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village reasonably expects to reimburse itself for the Expenditures with the proceeds of an obligation:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Resolved by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Zurich, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.
- Section 2. Intent to Reimburse. The Village reasonably expects to reimburse the Expenditures with proceeds of an obligation.
- Section 3. Maximum Amount. The maximum principal amount of the obligation expected to be issued for the Projects is \$1,500,000.
- Section 4. Ratification. All actions of the officers, agents and employees of the Village that are in conformity with the purposes and intent of this Ordinance, whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the

remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Repeal. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
